VIII. NEW BUSINESS

A. Power Point Presentation of the 2013 Conservation Projects

Director Tucker did a presentation for the Park Commission on the 2013 Conservation Projects and the grant funds that have been received to cover them.

In 2013, the Department will be prescribed burning 230.60 acres of land. The contractor for the burns this year is Plantwise, LLC.

For this year's burns the following are the units that will be burned:

Unit 8

Southern Meadow

Packaged Pricing

(Unit 9, 13, Hartman & NOHLC)

Shultz Park/Cemetery

In total the burns will cost \$ 19,605.00. The WHIP Grant Funds, which is administered by the Natural Resource Conservation Service, is funding unit 9, 8 and the Southern Meadow. The LIP Grant Funds, which is administered by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, is funding the Hartman property, NOHLC, Shultz Park/Cemetery and unit 13.

In 2013, the Department will be treating 212 acres of land for invasive species. Some of this work will be done in house and some will be contracted out. The LIP Grant Funds will be funding the treatment of Larry Hartman's property. The Whip Grant Funds will be funding the treatment of all of our units that are listed.

The following are the units/sites where invasive treatment will be taking place.

Larry Hartman Property – 10 acres of phragmites

Phragmites on STPR property - 5 acres

Unit 1 – 54 acres

Unit 2 - 40 acres

Unit 5 – 16 acres

Unit 7 – 20 acres

Unit 8 – 45 acres

Unit 13 - 22 acres

In total the Department will be spending \$ 9,630.60 on invasive species removal.

The last conservation project that Director Tucker went over is the Aquatic Weed Control for the Davisburg Mill Pond. Director Tucker stated that in the 2013 budget there is \$ 5,220.00 budgeted for Aquatic Weed Control for the Davisburg Mill Pond.

In 2012, the Park Commission awarded a two year contract for the mechanical weed harvesting to Professional Lake Management. The contract price is \$ 2,610.00 for 6 acres (\$435/acre).

Director Tucker also stated that the Department will be partnering with Oakland County Parks and Recreation on the chemical treatment of the pond as they have done in the past. In the past, it cost the Department approximately \$2,000.00 to have the chemical treatment performed for the season. However, since the Department started working with OCPR, our Department has only been charged the cost of the permit.
