You pay to have stormwater taken from your property when you pay your sewer bill. You pay to have it back when you want to water your lawn or garden. Why not just store it yourself instead of paying for it twice?



It was an idea our grandparents knew about...collecting rainwater for watering gardens and plants. With today's water shortages, contaminated runoff and watering bans, it just makes sense to hang on to the water that falls on your roof! It reduces the stormwater system burden faced by our municipalities and protects our river water quality from undesired sediments. Rain barrels recycle rain water, avoiding ponding, downspout flows on driveways, etc. **Why waste water which otherwise would flush into storm sewers and rivers?**

Water conservation is important and this barrel will help keep our water system clean. Fact sheet:

- 60 Gallon capacity, with the ability to connect several together for more storage
 - Made of 20% recycled materials
 - Strong, stable base, holds 500 pounds of water
 - Tight fitting lid means safety for children and animals, but can be removed to dip water or clean out
 - Attractive, dark green color discourages algae growth, blends in to foundation plantings
 - Gravity fed system, no electricity or special equipment needed except a garden or soaker hose. You may want to place bricks underneath to raise barrel off the ground for easier hose attachment.
 - Round shape means air can circulate around the barrel Made entirely in the USA
 - Brass faucet fitting at base allows nearly complete draining
 - **31 inches high, 28 inches wide-make sure it will fit in your vehicle at pick up**
 - Two overflow ports at the top, screening to keep out leaves and debris
 - A supply of mosquito dunks included
 - **Price only \$99.00 including tax**
