Supervisor Walls stated that under the chart covering ground signs, under Village Center, he thinks that what was initially suggested was to include Village Center. He asked if it got removed.

Commissioner Hines stated that in the last meeting, the Commission felt that there were no properties in the Village Center district to accommodate a ground sign.

Clerk Moreau commented that the lumberyard property and Barber property could accommodate a ground sign.

Commissioner Hines move to recommend the adoption of the amendments to Springfield Township Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 40, amending Section 40-628 and 40-681, relative to Automobile Repair Facilities and Offstreet Parking, Loading and Drive-Through Facilities. # 2. Ordinance Amendments – amend Springfield Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 40 – Zoning by amending Section 40-751 Sign Regulations, Section 40-645 Temporary Sales and Special Events and Section 40-2 Definitions

Commissioners discussed whether or not ground signs should be allowed in Village Center as appropriate. Commissioners concluded that ground signs should be allowed in Village Center and amended language should reflect the ground sign size should mimic OS and C1 and be a maximum of 8 feet high, 50 square feet on each side with a maximum of 100 square feet.

Commissioner Hopper moved to recommend to the Township Board amending Springfield Township Code of Ordinances, Chapter 40, Zoning, by amending Section 40-751 Sign Regulations, Section 40-645 Temporary Sales and Special Events and Section 40-2 Definitions subject to the addition of an edit of the chart on page 5 adding ground signs to Village Center with a maximum height of 8 feet, 50 square feet per side and a total of 100 square feet and further, to edit page 5, (3) adding reference to 40-751 (C)(2) as discussed this evening. Supported by Commissioner Hines. Vote: Voted yes: Baker, Hines, Hopper, Rusnell, Sclesky. Voted no: None. Absent: Mansour, Pliska. Motion Carried.
