Mr. Underwood noted that he wants to build inline with the houses along Claypool. He is trying to maintain the 100 foot setback from the lake. He explained that there was a road right-of-way that gave up thirty feet along Claypool which causes the problem. That was in addition to the twenty feet where Claypool is located now. Mr. Underwood provided an updated drawing to the Board.

Board Member Walls moved that the variance request for a twenty foot rather than a fifty foot setback from the Claypool road right-of-way be approved as the thirty foot additional right-of-way granted in the early 1980's is not being used and in all probability will not, that it creates a unique situation when combined with the size of the parcel in relationship to the buildable area, and that the circumstances are not the result of the applicant, the variance appears to be the minimum necessary for reasonable use of the property.
